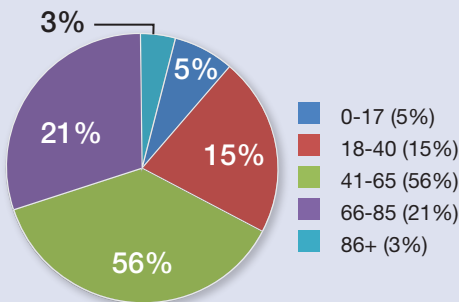
A spinal cord injury can happen to anyone at any age. In 2019, St. Luke's provided inpatient rehabilitation services to more than **150** inpatients and **39** outpatients who suffered a spinal cord injury or illness. This includes traumatic and non traumatic injuries resulting in tetraplegia or paraplegia. The ratio of male and female inpatient program is male **57%**, female **43%**. Outpatient program is male **85%**, female **15%**. Our inpatients receive an average of **3.6 hours of therapy per day**.

### Outpatient



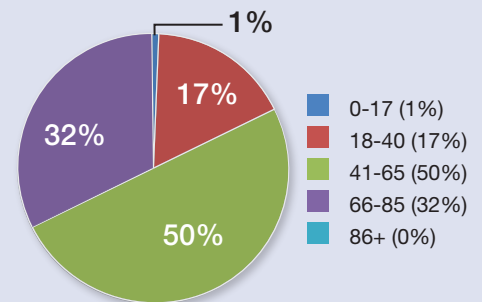
**51** average age of patients in outpatient rehabilitation
